

Andrea Marván Saltiel is appointed Chair Commissioner of Cofece

- *She was appointed by the Plenary of the Chamber of Senators for a four-year period, renewable once.*

Mexico City, March 15, 2023.- Commissioner Andrea Marván Saltiel today assumed the Chair of the Federal Economic Competition Commission (Cofece or Commission) for a four-year period, renewable once, in accordance with Article 28 of the Mexican Constitution, after being ratified by the Plenary of the Senate of the Republic. Since September 2021, the Chair was occupied by Brenda Gisela Hernández Ramírez, who, based on Article 19 of the Federal Economic Competition Law, was entrusted as Acting Chair Commissioner due to a vacancy.

Last December Andrea Marván Saltiel, after passing the knowledge exam applied by the Evaluation Committee, she was proposed by the head of the Federal Executive and ratified by the Plenary of the Upper Chamber to be commissioner of Cofece for a nine-year period. The new Chair Commissioner holds a degree in Law from the Universidad Iberoamericana and a master's degree in the same subject from the University of Chicago. She has ten years of professional experience at Cofece, where she has served in different positions. In addition, she was a professor at Tecnológico de Monterrey.

The commissioners and those who work at Cofece thank commissioner Brenda Hernández for her work as Acting Chair Commissioner due to a vacancy in favor of this Commission and wish Commissioner Andrea Marván success in her new assignment.
