Cofece submits for public consultation its draft amendment to the Regulatory Provisions on the Use of Electronic Means

- The purpose of the Regulatory Provisions is to establish the bases for the implementation, use and management of Electronic Means in the procedures and proceedings that are initiated or processed before Cofece, in order to facilitate their handling.
- The consultation opened on July 3 and will be open until July 22, 2023.

Mexico City, July 5, 2023.- The Federal Economic Competition Commission (Cofece or Commission) initiated the public consultation of its Draft Amendment to the Regulatory Provisions on the Use of Electronic Means in order to facilitate the processing of proceedings before the Commission through the use of the Electronic Procedures System.
