

Cofece enables the Electronic Filing Office for certain procedures

- *As of November 10, the Electronic Filing Office will be enabled for certain proceedings and procedures.*

Mexico City, November 9, 2023.- The Board of Commissioners of the Federal Economic Competition Commission (Cofece or Commission) published today in the Federal Official Gazette the Agreement by which the Board of the Federal Economic Competition Commission declares the Electronic Filing Office (OPE, per its initials in Spanish) enabled for certain procedures. This digital tool may be used for traditional proceedings and procedures before the Commission for which it had not been enabled; as well as those procedures that are carried out by electronic means when, according to its guidelines, the use of the OPE is allowed.

Starting November 10, 2023, the procedures in which, in accordance with the [Regulatory Provisions on the use of electronic means before the Federal Economic Competition Commission](#) (in Spanish), economic agents and authorities will be able to present promotions and process the actions notified to them by the Commission through the OPE, for which it will be necessary to register in the Electronic Procedures System (SITEC) ([SITEC Account Registration Manual](#) in Spanish).

In this way, Cofece reiterates its commitment to manage electronic means according to the principles of digital government and open data, benefiting users by reducing their time and guaranteeing transparency in each of the procedures carried out.
